

The Miracle Coffee Machine

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1. Introduction

The Miracle Coffee Machine is a compact, high-end appliance designed for home or office use. It features a stainless-steel exterior available in multiple color finishes and is suitable for a cozy countertop or easy pantry storage. The unit includes an integrated bean grinder that automatically processes your favorite whole beans. The adjustable settings accommodate various grind preferences. This machine supports both single and double espresso shots and includes a dual-function built-in steam wand to froth milk and dispense hot water. All functions are accessible via a control panel conveniently located on the front of the machine. The appliance is engineered for ease of use, cleaning, and routine maintenance. A limited warranty is included with purchase. This Miracle Coffee Machine is ideal for individuals seeking café-style beverages or specialty drinks with minimal setup and operation time.

2. Definitions of Key Terms



BPA-free plastic = plastic that is safe from toxic material and safe for consumption



Brew head = a hole where you place the espresso basket to create the infused espresso



Espresso basket = metal piece that is used to collect ground coffee



Grind hole = metal piece on top of the unit when the whole bean grinder and lid snap into place



Tamper = metal piece that looks like a stamp that is used to press the ground coffee into espresso basket



Stainless steel carafe = a container with a handle used to hold liquids



Water container attachment = the container that holds the water used by the machine



Whole bean grinder = the device that grinds the whole coffee beans

3. Technical Description

a. Components



- Items included:
 - Electric power cord
 - Main coffee machine
 - Espresso basket
 - Tamper
 - Stainless steel carafe
 - Water container attachment
 - Whole bean grinder with fid
 - Overflow collector pan
 - Cleaning kit products: cleaning tablets, replacement filters for water container, and small bottle of stainless-steel cleaner

Coffee beans and water are not included.

b. Specifications:

- Dimensions:
 - Height:
 - 13 inches (the main coffee machine)
 - 16 inches (unit with the whole bean grinder attached)
 - Width: 10 inches
 - Length: 11 inches
 - Weight:
 - 18 pounds (without water or beans)
 - 24.5 pounds (full water container and beans)

- Materials:
 - Stainless Steel Pieces:
Many of the pieces of the product are stainless steel. The five parts that are stainless steel are: the main coffee machine, the espresso basket, the tamper, and the carafe.
 - Plastic:
This product has pieces included in its assembly that are BPA-free plastic. These parts include: the water container attachment, the whole bean grinder with lid, and the overflow collector pan.
- Voltage and Electrical:
This product requires access to an electrical outlet that can provide a standard US 120-volt plug.
- Water Source:
This product requires the use of water to create a cup of coffee. It is not necessary to use filtered water as there is a built-in filter in the water container.

c. Overall Function

The Miracle Coffee Machine can achieve your perfect cup of coffee in five effortless steps:

1. *Prep The Machine*
Fill the water container and load the whole bean grinder with your favorite coffee beans. Then, simply press the power button to turn the machine on.
2. *Choose Your Espresso Type*
Select either a single or double espresso shot. The machine will automatically adjust its settings to accommodate your choice.
3. *Automatic Grinding*
The built-in grinder will freshly grind the whole beans and dispense directly into the espresso basket.
4. *Tamp and Lock*
Remove the filled espresso basket and use the tamper to press the grounds evenly. Slide the basket into the machine's brew head on the right side and lock it in place by turning the handle to right.
5. *Brew and Enjoy!*
Place your cup under the spout and press the brew button. Filtered water from the water container will flow through the tamped grounds creating a rich espresso shot directly into your cup.

d. Benefits

The Miracle Coffee Machine is quick and easy to assemble. The product has only seven large components that slide seamlessly into place. Disassembly is simple and accessible for cleaning-especially with the cleaning kit included. Designed for convenience, it manages all the hard work. You can enjoy café-quality beverages without leaving your house. The Miracle Coffee Machine is truly a miracle as it is timesaving, stress-free, and luxurious!



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4. Instructions

a. Assembly After Purchase

1. Carefully remove product from packaging as all will be wrapped individually.
2. First, locate a suitable power source and proper place for the Miracle Coffee Machine.

Suggestion: This product can be kept out on a countertop or stored in a pantry.

3. Before using this product, place the filter into the water container.



4. Place water container into the back of the coffee machine.
You will hear a clicking noise once it is properly installed.



5. Place the whole bean grinder with lid into the top left of the coffee machine.
Turn the knob labeled “TURN TO LOCK” to the left until it clicks.



6. Place tamper into hole directly below the whole bean grinder as indicated by the label and arrow.



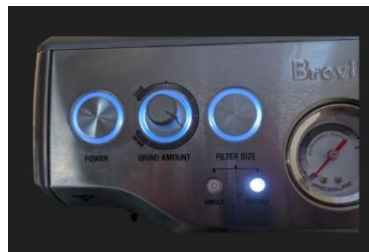
7. Slide drip tray into front of coffee machine.



8. Plug electrical cord into back of coffee machine.



9. Now, press the power button on the front of the coffee machine.
The buttons will light blue and a noise will indicate that the machine is now turned on.



10. The next steps will demonstrate how to make a cup of coffee.

a. How to Clean



The Miracle Coffee Machine Cleaning Kit includes:

- cleaning tablets
- replacement filters for water container
- small bottle of stainless-steel cleaner

To clean the water container

- Use water container tablets from the cleaning kit and drop into the water container then run a full coffee cycle.
- Dump water container after a full coffee cycle has been completed and then leave to air to dry.
- If there is a buildup, use a damp microfiber to clean the water container.

To clean the filters

- Replace the pull-out filter in the water container every 12 months to help purify the water going through the system.



To clean the whole bean grinder

- Make sure to dump out the beans in the grinder and clean using a damp microfiber cloth after unplugging the machine.

Small bottle stainless-steel cleaner

- Specialized cleaning vinegar spray can be used to clean the stainless-steel coffee machine front and stainless-steel pieces.

6. Warnings

- Do not overfill the water container or it will not work.
- Do not overfill the coffee bean storage area or it will not grind.
- Make sure to tighten down the espresso basket.
- Do not put your finger to the grinder to poke beans. We suggest using a spoon (see picture below.)



7. Troubleshooting

- Issue: espresso basket not filled with ground coffee
 - What is happening: whole beans not pushed down in the grinder
 - Indication: grinder noise will stop and espresso basket will not fill up
 - Solution: poke the whole beans until they continue to grind and fill the espresso basket
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- Issue: espresso gauge does not hit espresso range
 - What is happening: cup will still be full of coffee
 - Indication: espresso in coffee cup will be dark and the needle on the espresso range will not go into the correct espresso indicator
 - Solution: make sure the espresso basket is tightly attached to the brew head

8. Easy Coffee Recipes



a. Flat White

1. Measure milk into carafe.
2. Prepare espresso basket.
3. Click single or double shot button on the front panel.
4. Use tamper to press the ground beans.
5. Load basket into machine.
6. Add personal coffee cup or mug.
7. Press button to start brewing.
8. Wait for brewed coffee to finish.
9. Froth milk until correct consistency.
10. After coffee is brewed into cup, pour frothed milk on top of espresso.
11. If desired, you may stylize the foam into a design.
12. If desired, you may add extra milk foam onto coffee.
13. Clean espresso basket and carafe.

b. Single or Double Espresso

1. Prepare espresso basket.
2. Click single or double shot button on front panel.
3. Use tamper to press the ground beans.
4. Load basket into machine.
5. Add personal coffee cup or mug.
6. Press button to start brewing.
7. Wait for brewed coffee to finish.
8. Clean espresso basket.



c. Americano

1. Prepare espresso basket.
2. Click single or double shot button on front panel.
3. Use tamper to press the ground beans.
4. Load basket into machine.
5. Add personal coffee cup or mug.
6. Press button to start brewing.
7. Wait for brewed coffee to finish.
8. Take cup and align with knob to the hot water position and dispense the desired amount of hot water.
9. Clean espresso basket.
